There is an expectation that schools will maximise the efficacy of funding by pooling their resources appropriately across clusters/structured networks to maximise the impact and level of funding.

The primary purpose of the funding is creating time in schools for practitioners to make the changes to practice they need to make in advance of the realisation of the new curriculum.

As part of our Cluster Plan for Professional Development Cosheston V.C. School is involved in the following areas of training:

- The release costs to enable practitioners to collaborate both within school and across clusters and networks of schools – engaging with collaborative professional learning and collaborative planning -

‘Developing a whole cluster approach to transforming the health and well-being of our children through Physical Literacy and Mindfulness.’

Cosheston V.C. School – To enable schools to work collaboratively to develop their understanding of the AOLEs (Areas of Learning Experience), What Matter Statements and Progression Steps.

We aim to use this knowledge to work collaboratively to create a two-year planning cycle of themes/topics to provide coverage of the AOLEs.

1 teacher will be released for 4 days and the school will take part in a Physical Literacy Project: **SKIP training at Foundation Phase and Sports Education training at Key Stage 2.**
